



## CORPORAL SAFETY POLICY

The school ensures that the design of the building follows the guidelines for safety, in terms of exits, staircases and spaces, ramps and railings. Facilities, including the bathrooms in the campus, are maintained separately for boys and girls; and at a suitable distance from each other. The corridors and landings are well-lit and airy, and have convenient exits.

- The school ensures safety of children:
  - From accidents at/outside its premises while boarding buses, crossing roads in the vicinity, etc.
  - In school transport and field trips
  - From natural calamities, such as earthquakes, flooding, etc., and must have a relevant protocol in place.
  
- The school adopts measures to reduce physical hazards that put the safety of children at risk, such as:
  - Accidents on premises due to fire/short circuit
  - Improper/exposed wiring, improper location of panels in areas children frequently pass through, improper installation of MCBs
  - Storage of hazardous materials
  - Gas leakage and related risks
  - Water-related risks, such as open sumps, water pits

- Structural risks, such as loose false ceiling, cracks in the building, placement of furniture, obstruction in escape routes, broken/faulty play equipment, etc.
