Making word pictures with noun pairs_English

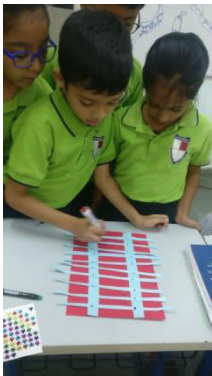
