For grades VI- VIII:

The test will be divided into two sessions-

Part I

- Type- Short answer questions- (one marker and two markers)
- Platform – Microsoft Forms
- Duration - 50 minutes
- Weightage - 40 marks

Part –II

- Type- Long Answer questions
- Platform- Microsoft Teams “Assignment”
- Duration- 1 hour 30 minutes
- Weightage- 40 marks

Guidelines for Students:

- a) Students to keep the following things ready when taking exams with pen and paper:

- i. Ruled long register sheet.
 - ii. Write Name, Date and Subject to be mentioned.
 - iii. Draw margins.
 - iv. Number the sheets.
- b) Students to keep their cameras switched on during the exam.
 - c) Student to avoid leaving the exam during the writing time. In case this happens, the parent is requested to inform the invigilator.
 - d) No answer sheet will be submitted after the allocated time.
