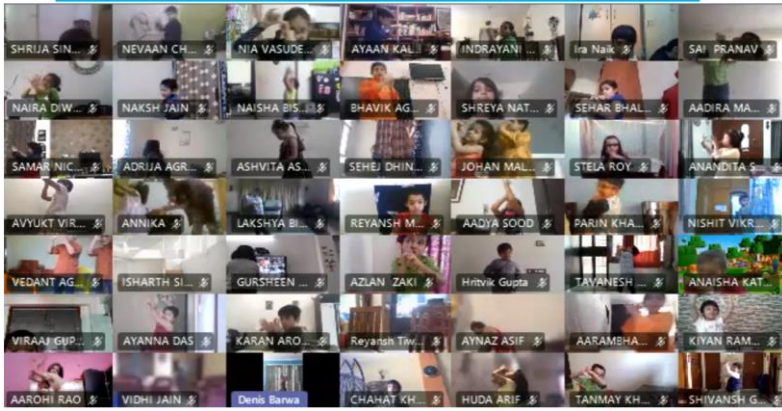
Grade – Nursery – II

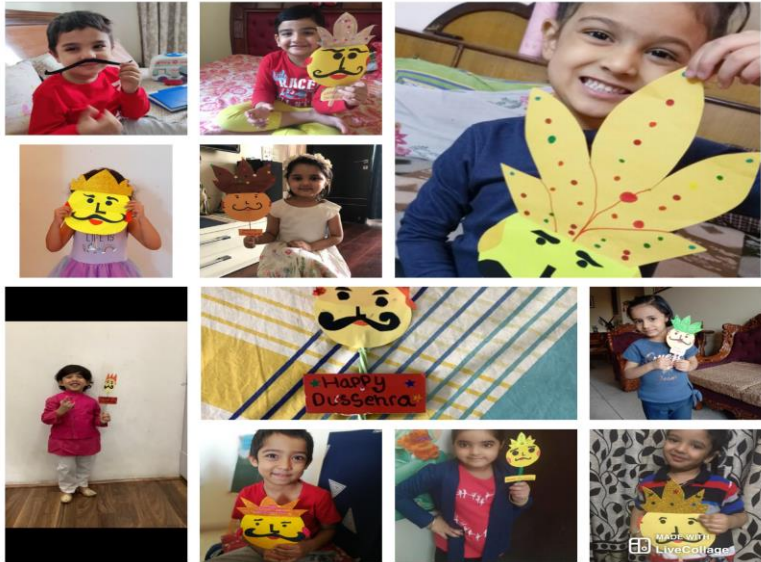

We enjoyed Garba dancing.....

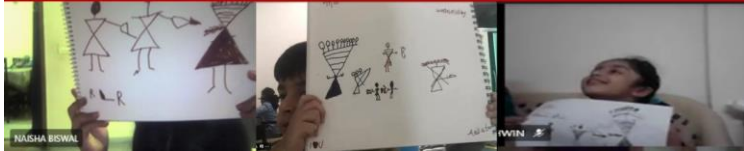


Dussehra celebration- Early years
